Towcester's 23rd Midsummer Music Festival, which is presented by the Rotary Club of Towcester, Towcester Town Council and supported by Towcester Mill Brewery, brings live music of all varieties to the heart of the town.

The festival is a community event, providing a platform for the musical talents of local primary and secondary schools, performing arts school, community choirs and orchestras, music students, brass bands, local artistes and more, including our regular headline act, the Lincoln Noel Jazz Trio.

The main event is organised by volunteers from the community and supports local charities. Whilst not officially part of the festival, over the years, town centre pubs have joined in the atmosphere by putting on their own free entertainment.

Our website will be regularly updated with all the latest information and the full community programme.

Tickets, starting from £2 per person, are on sale via the festival website and in person at Towcester Museum, for performances at Towcester Town Hall and St Lawrence Church and direct links to other performances at Towcester Mill Brewery and for the SNYE Silent Disco at the Community Centre.

Tickets may be sold on the door, subject to availability. Other venues and workshops are free of charge, or may charge a small charitable door entry fee. All venues welcome additional donations to the music festival's charity, Towcester NMPAT.

Meeting Point

If you have lost children, friends or relatives, or require first aid, please visit The Chantry House which will be staffed throughout the evening performances and will act as a meeting point and Help and Information Centre.

Food & Drinks






